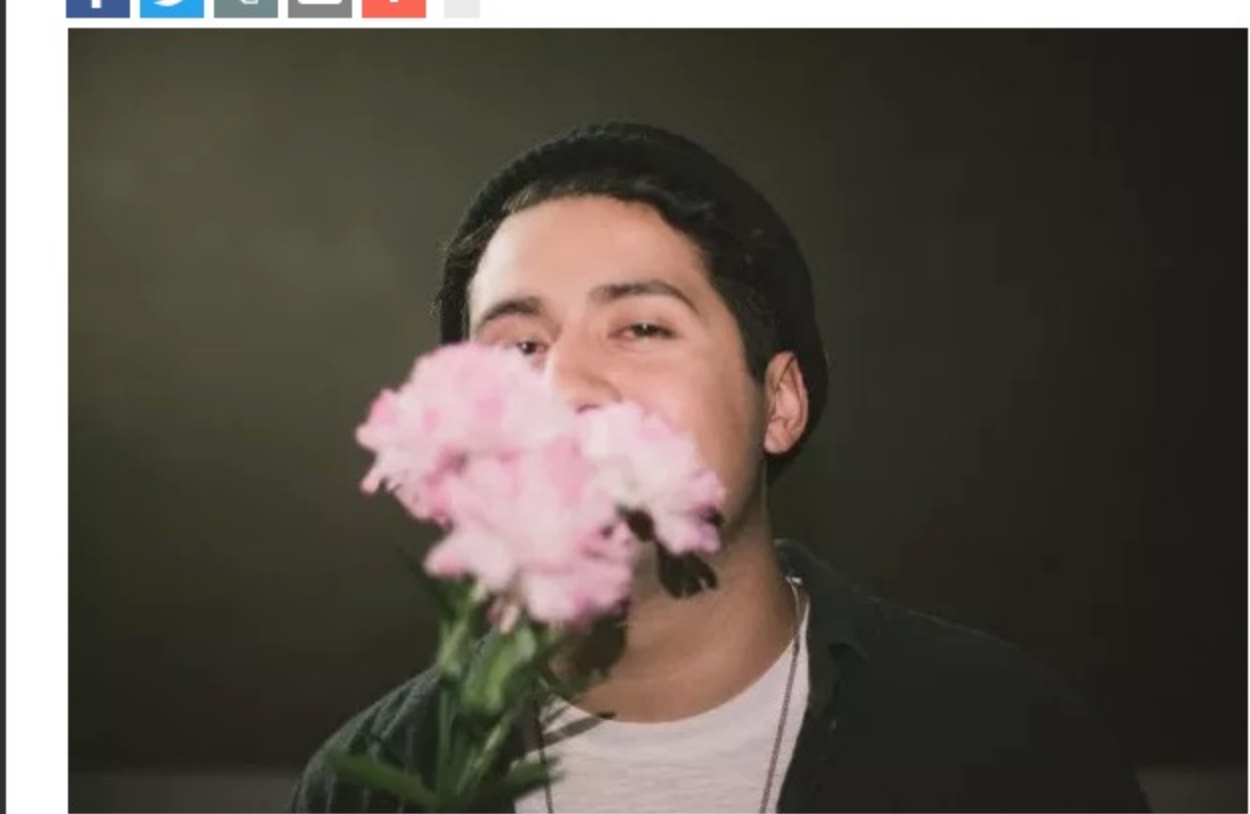

Ahead of debut, Katzù Oso will perform at Swedish American Hall

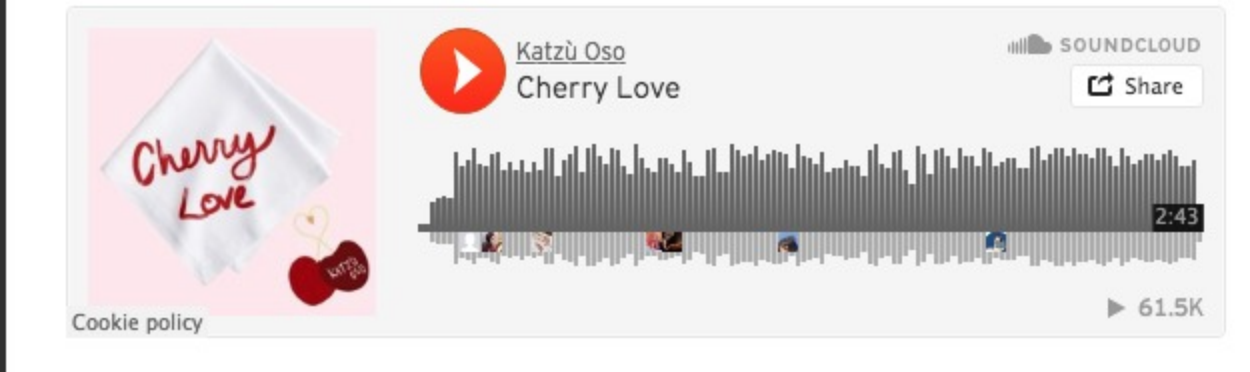

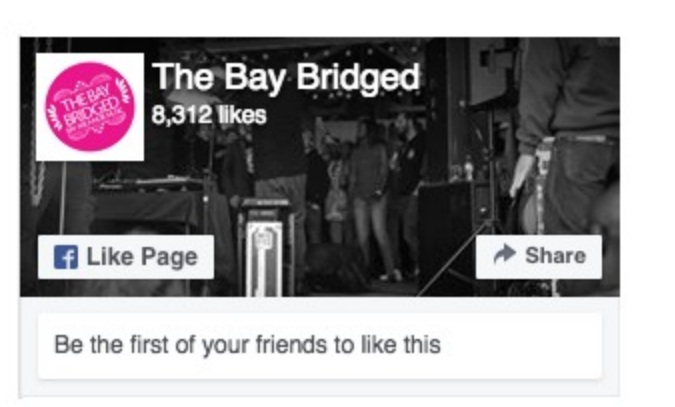

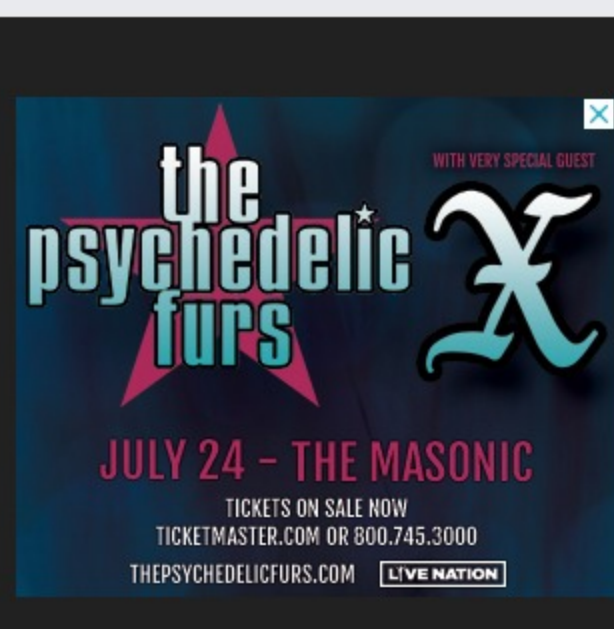
